## Are your patients eligible for a rebate?

The Government has a set of strict rules that apply to rebates for patients referred by Allied Health Professionals. Your patient may be eligible for a Medicare rebate for the following radiographic requests (with corresponding item numbers).

**Please note:** Government legislation prevents your referral of more than one three-region (58121) or four-region (58120) x-ray per patient in any 12 month period.

For any other examinations (not rebatable or NR item), your patient will incur a private fee. These are subject to our Radiologists' acceptance of the referral based on the service being "clinically relevant for the treatment of the patient's condition".
